'राहीबाई' एक अनोख व्यक्तिमत्व

आई' या राज्यस्तरावर प्रकाशित केल्या जाणाऱ्या ग्रंथाचा प्रकाशन सोहळा.११२१ कवितांचा समावेश असलेला. सी.ए.डॉ. शंकर अंदानी सर, समर्थ फाउंडेशनचे संस्थापक किरण इनामदार सर तसेच सतीश पाटील सर व सीताट्रस्ट यांच्या अथक प्रयत्नाने रंगलेला हा सोहळा. या भव्य दिव्य होणाऱ्या सोहळ्यात ११ पद्मश्रींना प्रमुख अतिथी म्हणून आमंत्रित केले गेले होते. त्यात एक नऊवारी साडी घातलेली स्त्री कोण बरे असेल? हा प्रश्न सर्वांना पडला होता. आयोजकांनी जेव्हा बाईचं नाव घेतलं आणि त्या माईकवर बोलायला लागल्या त्यावेळी तर मी अचंबित झाले. त्या बाई म्हणजे 'बीजमाता' राहीबाई पोपरे.

एका छोट्याशा गावात जन्मलेल्या ह्या बाईने वडिलांकडून मिळालेल्या संस्कारांचा योग्य रीतीने वापर करून सर्वानसमोर एक आदर्श निर्माण करून दिला आहे.

राहीबाई यांनी कोणत्याही प्रकारचे शिक्षण घेतलेला नाही तरीही त्या खूप छान बोलू शकत होत्या. त्यांचे व्यक्तिमत्व त्यांच्या प्रत्येक शब्दातून झळकत होते. महाराष्ट्रातील अहमदनगर जिल्ह्यातील अकोले तालुक्यातील कोंभाळणे या छोट्याशा गावात राहणारी ही स्त्री. घरातील मंडळी जेव्हा आजारी पडायला लागली, तेव्हा त्यांना असा प्रश्न पडला की हे आजार कुठून येतात? त्यांना असं वाटलं की याच्यावर आपण विचार केला पाहिजे आणि त्यातूनच त्यांना लक्षात आले की आपण आपल्या लहानपणी कधी आजारी पडलोच नाही. आत्ताची ही जी पिढी आहे ती वारंवार आजारी पडते आहे. आधीची बाळं कुपोशीत दिसत नव्हती परंतु आता बाळाचा जन्म होतो, तेव्हाच त्यांचे वजन कमी असते. यामागे काहीतरी कारण असावं आणि

त्यामागे त्यांनी शोध घेतला तेव्हा त्यांच्या लक्षात आलं की संकरित बाणामुळे आपली रोगप्रतिकारक क्षमता कमी तर होत नाही ना! असा विचार त्यांच्या मनात आला आणि त्यांनी त्यावर काहीतरी उपाय शोधण्याची खूणगाठ बांधली. आज कालच जे रसायन युक्त खाणं आपण खात आहोत त्यातूनच ह्या आजारांची निर्मिती होत आहे आणि म्हणूनच त्यांनी पारंपारिक शेती पद्धतीतून पारंपारिक बीज बियाणातून शेती करावी हा निर्णय घेतला. पारंपारिक बियांचे संवर्धन करून त्यांनी शेती केली. त्यातून चे उत्पन्न आले ते अस्सल देशी उत्पन्न होते.

राहीबाई यांनी त्यांच्या सीड बँकेत २५० हून अधिक वाणाच्या बियांचे संकलन व संवर्धन केलेले आहे. या क्षेत्रातील कामाबद्दल त्यांना 'बीजमाता' म्हणून ओळख मिळाली तसेच देशातील चौथा सर्वोच्च पुरस्कार प्रदान करण्यात आला आहे तो म्हणजे 'पद्मश्री' पुरस्कार. त्यांच्याशी गप्पा मारल्यावर एवढे लक्षात आले की आपण केलेले काम जर योग्य असेल तर त्याची जाहिरात करायची गरज भासत नाही त्याची पोच पावती आपोआप सर्वांना मिळते.

आचार्य विनांबा भावे यांचे जीवन अत्यंत साधे आणि संयमी होते त्यांच्यात ऋषीप्रमाणे शांतता, त्याग आणि आत्मशुद्धी दिसून येते. सत्य अहिंसा आणि मानवसेवा हे त्यांच्या जीवनाचे मुख्य आधार होते.

त्यांचा जन्म ११ सप्टेंबर १८९५ मध्ये निसर्गाच्या कुशीतील गागोदे या गावी आली. लहानपणापासूनच त्यांना अध्यात्म, सत्य आणि सेवा यांची आवड होती. ते महात्मा गांधीचे निष्ठावंत शिष्य होते त्यांनी फ्रेंच भाषेसोबतच संस्कृत भाषेचा अभ्यासही सुरू करून त्यातून त्यांनी वेदांचा अभ्यास करून वेदांतील विचार सामान्य माणसालाही समजेल असा त्यांचा प्रयत्न होता. तसेच त्यांना ज्ञानश्वरीसुद्धा अत्यंत प्रिय होती. त्यांनी ज्ञानश्वरीतील कर्मयोग, भक्ती आणि ज्ञान यांचा आपल्या जीवनात अवलंब केला.

भूदान चळवळीतून त्यांनी अनेक जमिनहीन लोकांना जमिनी मिळवून दिल्या त्याचबरोबर चंबळच्या खोप्यातील डाकूंच्या मनात सुद्धा शस्त्रशक्तीपेक्षा शब्दशक्तीचा प्रभाव मोठा असतो हे दाखवून दिले.

Let's explore a few:

Fibonacci's:

(Sequences of numbers where each number is sum of two preceding ones)

Flowers:

The arrangement of petals, leaves, and seeds in flowers. Examples include sunflowers, roses, and daisies.

Fractal Frenzy:

Fractals are self-repeating patterns found in trees, mountains, rivers, and even our own DNA. They show how simple rules create complex beauty.

Symmetry in Animals:

Many animals, like butterflies and starfish, exhibit symmetry in their bodies, which is a mathematical concept.

Honeybee Hexagons:

Honeybees build hexagonal cells to store honey, using the most efficient shape to maximize space.

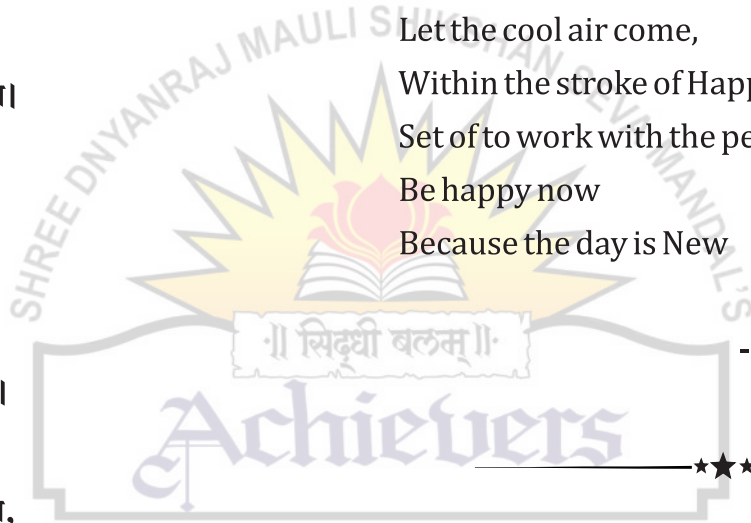

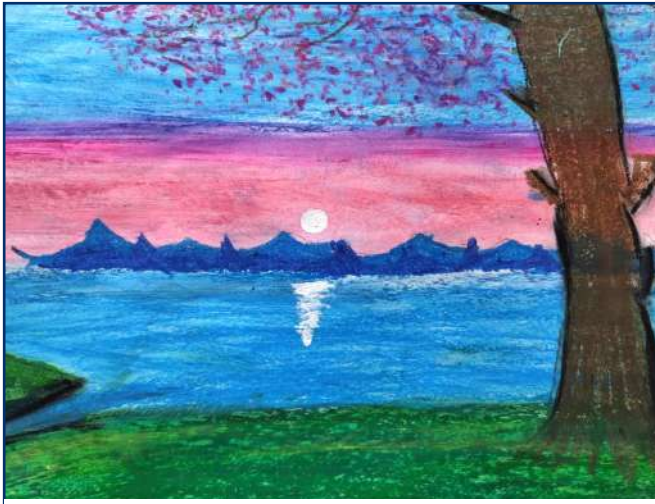

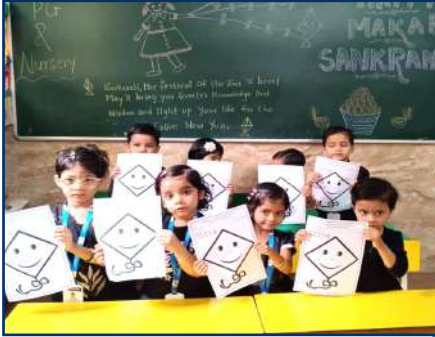
